CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT

Guests are welcome to check-in between the hours of 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. on the date of arrival. The primary check-in location is in the lobby of your assigned residence hall. All guests are required to check-out between the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. on the date of departure. Upon check-out, guests are asked to dispose of all trash by placing it within our designated trash rooms, located centrally on each residence hall floor. Guests are additionally asked to double check that all personal property is collected prior to departure.

Requests for arrival and departure times beyond the scope of the standard hours must be communicated in advance and approved by the office of Conference Services.

JASPER CARD

All overnight guests are required to carry a Manhattan College assigned ID card during your stay on campus at all times, the Jasper Card. Your first and last name along with the name of your program is displayed on the front of the card. The cards advanced technology allows access into your assigned residence hall and entry into Locke's Loft Dining Hall (if applicable). If your Jasper Card is lost, stolen or not working properly, please report this to your program director. A replacement fee of \$10 per card will be applied to the program.

COMBINATION CODES

A two- to four-digit number will be issued for your use to gain entrance into your assigned residence hall suite/room for all residential buildings. If one of your numbers within your combination code is comprised of two digits (ex: 12), you must push in the #1 and #2 button at the same time to enter the number 12. Please contact your program director for any complications or to report an issue with suite/room entrance. DO NOT share your suite/room combination code. This is a private number and should remain confidential as it pertains directly to you and your roommate's security and privacy.

ROOM CHANGES

Room changes can only be granted by the director of your program.

Switching rooms and combination codes with another guest is not permitted.

RESIDENCE HALLS

Eight Floor Access

Access into Horan and Lee Hall is available through an entrance/exit on the eigth floor. Access will be granted from the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 12:00 a.m. (midnight) by swiping your Jasper Card at the posted card reader. Eighth floor access will be denied after 12:00 a.m. (midnight) when all guests are required to enter/exit through the first floor lobby.

Lounges

Furnished lounges are located on each floor within Horan and Lee Halls with kitchenettes, study areas and flat-panel LCD TVs. The lounge in Jasper Hall is located on the first floor. Lounges may be reserved for your group for private use, otherwise they are public spaces.

Game Rooms

Recreational rooms with billiards and pingpong tables are located within Horan Hall, first floor, and Jasper Hall, second floor. Recreational rooms may be reserved for your group for private use, otherwise they are public spaces.

Laundry

Free washer and dryer access is available on each floor of Horan and Lee Halls and in the basement of Jasper Hall. Guests are required to provide their own detergent, which is available for purchase at the Manhattan College Bookstore, located in the Kelly Commons.

GUEST CONDUCT AND HOUSING POLICIES

Drugs and Alcohol

Manhattan College guests are expected to comply with alcohol laws of New York state, especially as they relate to underage drinking. Under current New York state law, individuals under 21 years of age may not possess or consume alcoholic beverages, nor may individuals over 21 years of age furnish alcoholic beverages to those less than 21 years of age.

Below please find a list of the Manhattan College regulations regarding alcohol and campus facilities:

- All guests present in private residence hall rooms where alcoholic beverages are being consumed must be 21 years old.
- Possession or use of alcohol serving equipment, including but not limited to beer pong tables, beer ball containers, kegs, taps, funnels and bars, is prohibited.
- · Drinking games are prohibited.
- Any quantity of alcoholic beverages (e.g., beer, wine, liquor) brought into a residence hall that, in the judgment of College personnel/staff, may cause injury or harm will be confiscated and disposed of without reimbursement.
- Guests may not bring alcoholic beverages into any unauthorized areas.
- Being in a state of intoxication is a violation of the Manhattan College Code of Conduct.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in all Manhattan College facilities, enclosed workplace areas and residence halls. This includes all offices, work spaces, common work areas, overnight accommodations, auditoriums, classrooms, conference and meeting rooms, elevators, hallways, medical facilities, cafeterias, employee lounges, staircases, parking garages, restrooms and all other enclosed areas in the workplace.

Smoking is also prohibited in any outdoor event with seating and within 25 feet of any building entrance or ventilation system.

Suite Doors, Furniture and Equipment

DO NOT leave suite doors open, unattended or propped open as this pertains directly to you and your roommate's security and privacy. Furniture from the residence halls may not be removed, reconfigured or damaged. This includes and is not limited to mattresses, bed frames and desks. Room windows MUST be closed while the AC units are in use to avoid equipment damage or possible condensation.

Ouiet Hours

Courtesy hours are in effect 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. This means that music, conversation and all other noise should be respectful of community living. Quiet hours are from Sunday through Monday, 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.

SECURITY, EMERGENCIES AND FIRE SAFETY Public Safety

Manhattan College's Public Safety office provides a safe and secure environment for the entire campus community. They are available to provide assistance and emergency response 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for all students, staff, visitors and guests. Officers and supervisors conduct foot and vehicle campus patrols during three tours throughout the day and night. Their 24/7 main security booth is located at the main gate of the campus, which is home to their main call center (718) 862-7500. For emergencies ONLY, please call (718) 862-7333 or 911.

Fire Safety

Fire poses a serious risk to everyone on campus, and fire safety equipment, such as smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, fire alarm pull boxes and emergency routing signs, are installed in each College facility and residence hall for your protection. Tampering with or misusing any fire safety device, jeopardizes your safety and the safety of others and will result in consequences. Actions considered a violation of fire safety regulations include, but are not limited to:

- Tampering with fire alarms, fire extinguishers, fire doors, sprinklers, etc.
- Smoking indoors
- Disposing of lit tobacco products in trash receptacles
- Starting or maintaining any open flame in unauthorized College spaces (i.e. residence halls, library, classroom, etc.)
- Blocking or locking fire exits
- Propping doors open
- Lighting of candles or other devices inside residence halls or other buildings

TRANSPORTATION

Subways and Buses

The nearest public transportation is the NYC MTA No. 1 subway line, which extends to lower Manhattan. MTA MetroCards may be purchased in advance for groups through our Conference Services office. The Campus Bookstore also sells MetroCards for individual purchase, and they are available at each station platform. MTA buses also run along Broadway, just down the hill from campus and near the 242nd Street subway station. Bus routes near the College are the 7, 10 and 24, all of which stop at West 239th Street and Riverdale Avenue.
