STEP 1: ACTIVATE YOUR JASPERNET ACCOUNT

Go to <https://start.manhattan.edu/activater>

As part of the new student activation process, an email was sent to your personal account containing your JasperNet account username, along with prompts to establish a secure password.

STEP 2: LOG INTO SELF-SERVICE

The office of Financial Aid Administration utilizes Self-Service to provide future Manhattan College students with a secure, internal system to manage student accounts online.

Using your JasperNet account credentials, you can log into Self Service to:

- View current information about your financial aid
- Accept your award letter offers
- Satisfy requests for missing information, such as FAFSA verification
- View your student employment eligibility
- View financial aid-related account holds
- View information about a student's academic progress (impacts financial aid eligibility)

JASPER CORPS

STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

There are two types of student employment funding — federal work-study (FWS) and campus employment (CE). Students are eligible for one or the other, and can see this information on their award letter.

- 1. Federal Work Study:** FWS is first and foremost a federal financial aid program.
- 2. Campus Employment:** Manhattan College matches federal funds in the form of our campus employment portion. It is because of this federal funding that our student employment program is possible.

From academic departments and Events Management or Conference Services to Athletics and Admissions, nearly every office at the College hires student workers to support their daily tasks and responsibilities.

MENTOR PROGRAM

The Mentor Program is one of Manhattan College's most popular and successful career development programs. As a first-year student, you will be matched with a professional mentor (often a Manhattan College alumnus) who works in your intended industry or career, and you will spend the year learning about opportunities within the field. Aside from required orientations, a meet-and-greet, and an end-of-year dinner, all activities are up to the mentor and mentee.
