Summer Pell Form

In order to receive Pell, a student must be financially eligible for a Pell Grant based on the data submitted on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). In addition, students must also: be matriculated, working towards their first bachelor's degree and taking three or more credits in a particular semester.

Unless the student is graduating or enrolled for part-time study during the academic year, a student who is receiving Pell for the summer, fall and spring semesters will need to be enrolled in at least six credits for the summer period.

A student needs to complete at least 25 credits for the entire year in order to receive a Pell award for summer, fall and spring. This means that if six credits are taken over the summer, then 19 credits need to be completed between fall, winter and spring of that academic year. Students need to consider this requirement in the event that, if a student withdraws from any class(es), their spring award can be reduced if this 25-credit minimum is not met.

Federal Pell funds cannot be disbursed to your student account until the verification process is complete. It is, therefore, imperative that all requested documents are promptly submitted to the Office of Financial Aid Administration.
