Dear Adjunct Faculty:

We have just received official confirmation from the New York office of the NLRB that adjunct faculty have until March 9, 2011 to return mail ballots to the NLRB. A ballot count has been scheduled for March 10. However, because the NLRB in Washington has granted review of the Region's decision on jurisdiction over Manhattan College, while review is underway, ballots will be impounded and not counted.

We understand that ballots have been sent to those on the lists of adjunct faculty for Spring 2010 and Fall 2010 that the College provided previously to the NLRB. If you have not received a ballot and believe you are eligible please contact the NLRB office immediately so that you can be sent a ballot. If you have a ballot please vote. Even if you think that your ballot may not be received by the NLRB by March 9, please mail in the ballot since ballots may not be counted on March 10 and we understand that ballots received before the count is actually conducted will be included.
